**A contractor that is a single-member limited liability company (LLC) provided over \$600 worth of services. Do we still have to send the contractor a 1099 form?**

If you are paid \$600 or more for your work for any individual client, you should receive a 1099-NEC from your customer. If you receive payments through online payment services such as PayPal, you may also receive a form 1099-K. And, yes, the IRS gets a copy, too.

**What are your starting prices for tax returns?**

**I heard that full time students don't have to pay taxes. Is that true?**
